2. THE "CARTA"

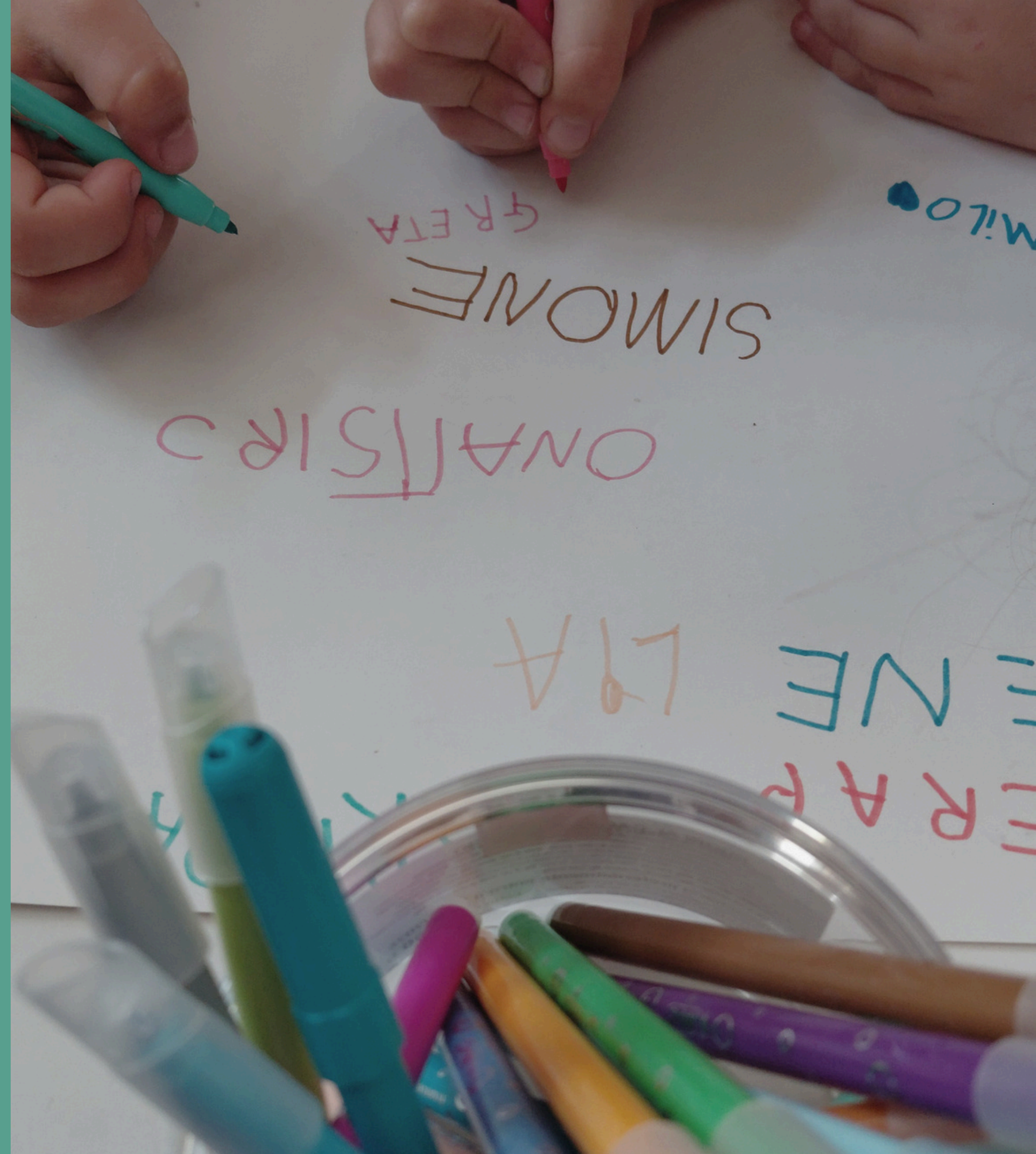
We build the classroom rules together during the assembly, starting from the question:

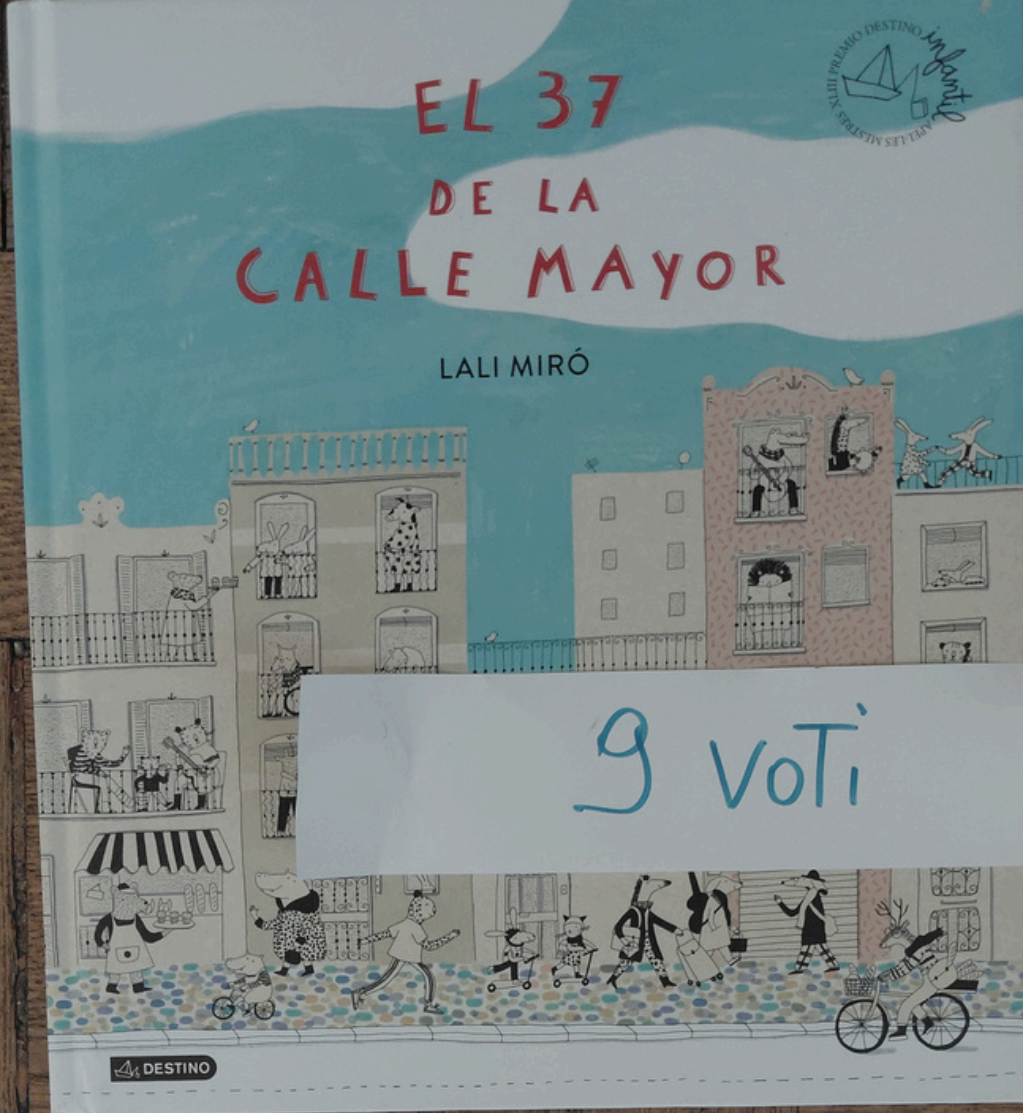
'What do we need to feel good together?'

👉 helping children understand that rules are created by everyone

The shared and signed charter is displayed in a visible space in the classroom.

👉 making the democratic process visible





3. VOTIAMO!

We make real decisions together: choosing a story to read, deciding on a game, choosing a workshop activity...

We vote by raising our hands.

👉 understanding the meaning of the majority and of shared decision-making



4. THE CONFLICT GAME

We simulate small conflict situations or take inspiration from real-life situations.

We observe the scene, propose solutions, and vote for the best one.

👉 learning how to manage conflicts and develop empathy
